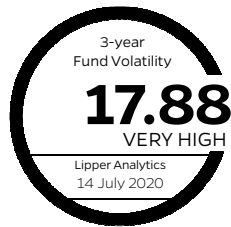


## BIMB *i*-TACTICAL FUND



### FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

Malaysia's equity market benchmark, the FBM Emas Shariah Index was higher by 11.63% during the month of July to close at 13,439.53 points. The Fund's performance on the other hand had increased by 6.61% during the same period under review due to slightly defensive stance undertaken for the fund.

For the month of July 2020, Health Care and Industrials were the best performing sectors for the fund led by Pharmaniaga Berhad and Supermax for Health Care, and Sarawak Consolidated Industries Berhad for Industrials. The underperforming sectors for the fund were Energy and Communication Services led by MMHE and Serba Dinamik for Energy and Telekom Malaysia for Communication Services.

The Fund is of the view that multiple issues will continue to challenge local and global market with the most pressing one being the Covid-19 impact on economy. The Fund intends to strategize the investment strategy by having ample cash holdings and beginning to have foreign market exposure, while continuing to monitor the overall market condition to react in the best interest of the unit holders.

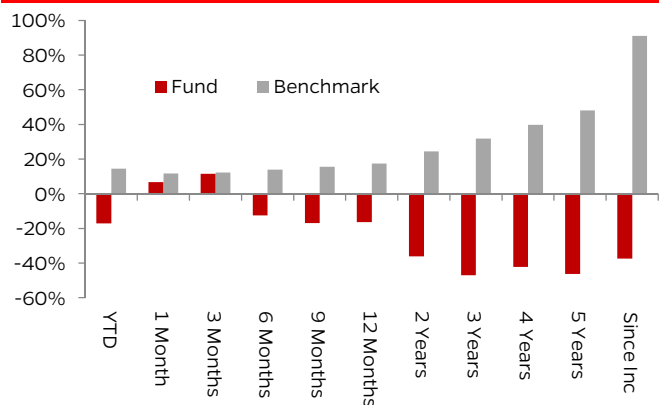

Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at **14 July 2020** the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is **17.88** and is classified as "**Very High**". The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified Funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only Funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
