FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

The FBMS Index was up by 2.20% due to improving market sentiment driven by strong rebound in Dow Jones Index as well as Nasdaq Index during the month. The fund's NAV had increased by 7.56% on 1-month basis and outperformed its benchmark by 6.38% as the fund's high equity weightage had benefited its performance greatly upon market rebound.

While WHO had declared the Monkeypox outbreak another public health emergency of international concern and same level with Covid-19's status, global travel and re-opening trends is expected to continue as there is also a vaccine for Monkeypox disease. Therefore, the fund will continue to adapt a fully invested mode to ride on market rebound potentials for 2H 2022 as the pace of interest rate hike by US Fed is expected to be reduced due to recession issues faced by the US economy. Tactically, the fund will also increase its exposure in Technology stocks slightly to ride on the strong demand for EV and Semiconductors products in the future.

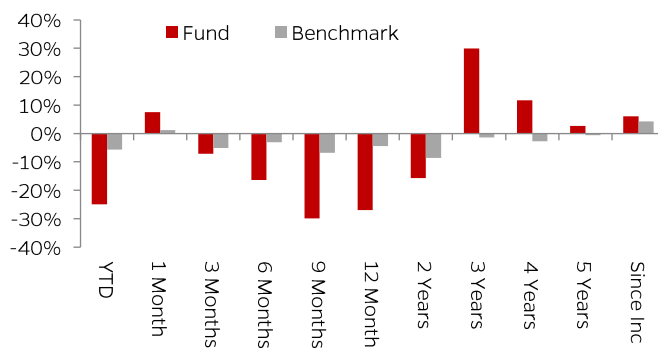
