FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

The FBMS Index was down by 3.68% in November driven by negative impact from the surprised one-off 9% Cukai Makmur for companies with net income of above RM100m as announced during the budget 2022 tabling by the federal government as well as panic selling across global equities due to the emergence of a more transmissible Covid-19 variant, "Omicron", that had created fears of reintroduction of lockdown measures to contain the spread of this new variant. As a result, the fund's performance had decreased by 4.78% on 1-month basis and underperformed its benchmark by 2.20% as economy re-opening related stocks and technology stocks prices had declined more than Index stocks due to the negative developments mentioned above.

Despite the commencement of Singapore-Malaysia Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) on 29th November that is able to help boost both country's economic activity, one cannot discount the possibility of another lockdown measures being implemented again if the Omicron variant starts to spread rapidly in the region which might cause travelling activities to slow down. Therefore, the fund had raised its cash holdings to above 10% level as a tactical defensive move to reduce downside in case another nationwide lockdown is being implemented again in the future.

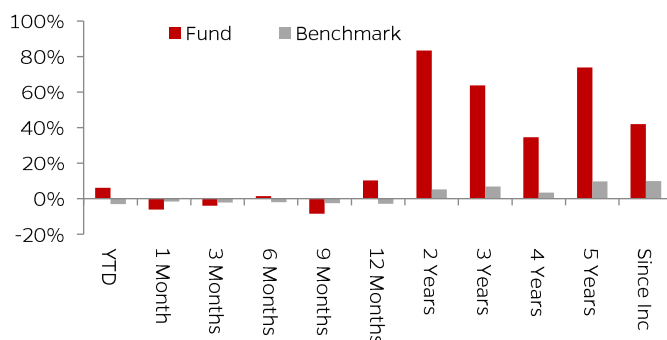
