FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

The FBMS Index was up by 1.44% as window dressing activity in the US market had boosted the market performance of Bursa Malaysia in December. The fund's NAV had increased by 0.35% on month-on-month basis but underperformed its benchmark by 0.61% as the fund's holdings in technology sector did not benefit from the window dressing activity as much during the period under review.

Meanwhile, Malaysia's GDP performance continues to show encouraging signs in 2022, while we are looking at a GDP growth of between 4.5% and 5.5% in 2023. Overall, the fund will maintain its investments in growth-oriented stocks to position itself for better NAV recovery, as technology stocks in Malaysia are set to benefit from global semiconductor growth in the EV and smart devices segments. As China enters its endemic phase of dealing with the virus and economic activity resumes, the fund's holdings in semiconductor-related stocks should benefit, as the Chinese Android phone market is expected to rebound strongly at the soonest by 1Q 2023.

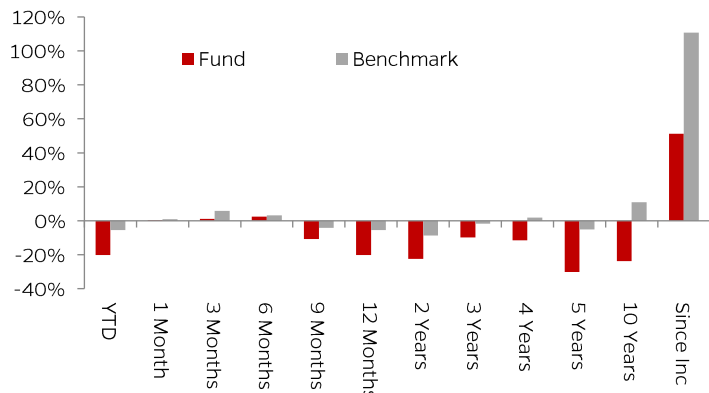

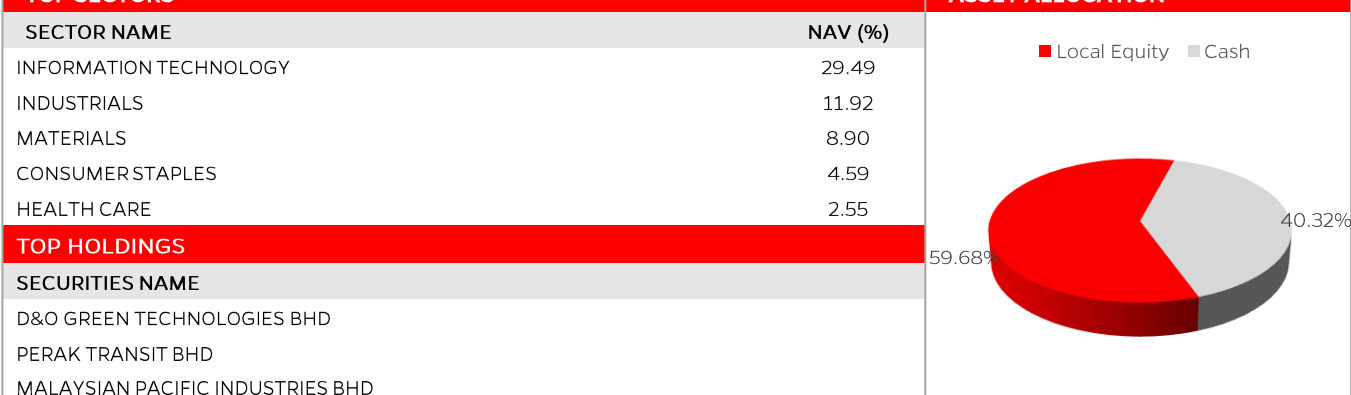
