FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

Malaysia's equity market benchmark, the FBM Shariah Index was down by 2.03% during the month of August to close at 13,166.65 points, ending the four-month winning streak enjoyed since April. The fall was driven by profit-taking activities and potentially concerns about the end of the loan moratorium happening in September, which could lead to weakness in KLCI due to possible lower retail participation rate.

The fund however was marginally up by 0.20% for the month, thereby outperforming its benchmark by 2.23%, thanks to positive performance by Energy, Real Estate, Communication Services, Information Technology and Health Care sectors which offset the sizable negative movement by Industrials, Materials, Utilities and Consumer Staples. The biggest contributor to the fund performance was Serba Dinamik Holdings Berhad and Supermax Corporation Berhad, while the laggards were Kossan Rubber Industries Berhad and Fraser & Neave Holdings Berhad.

Moving forward, the Fund intends to reduce its cash holdings in favour of equity allocation to position for post Covid19 economy recovery, looking beyond 2020 to a brighter 2021, as we are already approaching the end of the year. The Fund will continue to monitor the overall market condition to react in the best interest of the unit holders.

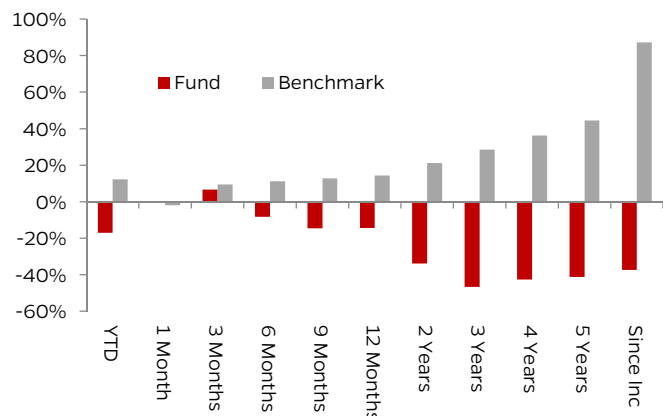


